Instructions for the use of the documentation

INTERNET

FORM: Consent for processing data

Include this clause in the form from where the Data Subject's data are collected.

An "I accept" button, or an "I have read and accept..." selector giving consent must be added to the bottom of the form to confirm that the consent clause for processing personal data has been read.

The system will not send the form with the data if consent has not been confirmed.

WEBSITE: Legal notice

Place this legal notice on a link visible on all pages of the website.

WEBSITE: PRIVACY Policy

A link to the privacy policy must be visible on all pages of the website.

Mandatory clause regarding obtaining and/or storing personal data (identification data, photographs, emails, etc.)

COOKIES: Cookies Policy (STAFF)

LSSI: Cookies Policy regulations for cookies that require the user's consent to be installed, and that are not of a technical nature, and are necessary for the operation of the website or the provision of services expressly requested by the user.

If the website installs Google Analytics cookies by default (_ga/_utm), it will be necessary for an informative BANNER to be visible from all parts of the website until the user ACCEPTS the processing.

COOKIES: Requirements for VALID CONSENT to use cookies

The requirements for consent to be considered valid and the most common procedure for obtaining consent for the installation of Google Analytics are established.

Use of Cookies

This website uses technical cookies (small files with information that the server sends to the computer of the website user) in order to carry out certain functions considered necessary for the correct functioning and preview of the website. In any case, the cookies used are temporary, with the sole purpose of making navigation of the site more efficient, and disappear at the end of the user's session. Under no circumstances do these cookies themselves provide personal data and will not be used for the collection of such data.

1. USER INFORMATION

BIOARRAY S.L., hereinafter DATA CONTROLLER, is the Controller of the User's personal data and informs him/her that these data shall be processed in accordance with the provisions of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of 27 April (GDPR) and the Organic Law 3/2018 of 5 December (LOPDGDD), providing the following information on the processing:

2. COMPULSORY OR OPTIONAL NATURE OF THE INFORMATION PROVIDED BY THE USER

The Users, by marking the corresponding boxes and entering data in the fields, marked with an asterisk (*) in the contact form or download forms, accept expressly and in a free and unequivocal way that their

data are necessary for the supplier to meet their request, voluntarily providing their data in the remaining fields. The User ensures that the personal data provided to the CONTROLLER are true and is responsible for communicating any changes to them.

COOKIES: Cookies Policy (STAFF)

INFORMATION ABOUT COOKIES

Due to the coming into force of the amendment to the "Law on Services of the Information Society" (LSSICE) established by Spanish Royal Decree 13/2012, it is mandatory to obtain the express consent of the user of all web pages that use non-essential *cookies* before browsing them.

¿WHAT ARE COOKIES?

Cookies and other similar technologies such as local shared objects, flash *cookies* or pixels, are tools used by Web servers to store and retrieve information about their visitors, as well as to enable the proper functioning of the site.

Through using these devices, the Web server is able to remember some data concerning the user, such as their preferences for viewing the server's pages, their name and password, products that interest them most, etc.

COOKIES AFFECTED BY, AND COOKIES EXEMPT FROM REGULATIONS

According to the EU directive, the *cookies* that require the user's informed consent are analytical, advertising and affiliation *cookies*, while technical cookies and those that are necessary for the operation of the website or the provision of services expressly requested by the user are exempt.

¿WHAT KIND OF COOKIES ARE THERE?

There are five main groups of cookies:

- *Analytical Cookies*: these collect information on how the website is used.
- *Social Cookies*: these are required for external social networks.
- *Affiliate Cookies*: these allow you to track visits through links from other websites, with which the website establishes affiliate agreements (affiliate companies).
- *Advertising and behaviour Cookies*: these collect information on the user's personal preferences and choices (*re-targeting*).
- *Technical and functional Cookies*: these are strictly only necessary for the use of the website and for the provision of the contracted service.

COOKIES USED BY THIS WEBSITE

List the cookie names, types, owners, functions and expiration dates, for example:

- **PHPSESSID**: technical and strictly necessary *cookies* that contain the session identifier. It is deleted when you close your browser.
- **_lang**: technical and strictly necessary *cookies* that contain the language of the session. It is deleted when you close your browser.
- **ac_cookies**: technical and strictly necessary *cookies* that contain the value of whether the installation of cookies has been accepted. It expires 1 year after the last update.
- **_ga**: Google Analytics *cookies* that allow you to control unique visits. A *cookie* will be installed the first time a user logs into the website using a browser. When this user visits the website again using the same browser, the *cookie* distinguishes that it is the same user. Only if the user changes their browser will they be considered a different user. It expires 2 years after the last update.
- **_gat**: This *cookie* is associated with Google Analytics Universal. It is used to limit the request rate - limiting the collection of data on high-traffic sites. It expires after 10 minutes.
- **_utma**: Google Analytics *cookie* which records the date of the first and last time that the user visited the website. It expires 2 years after the last update.
- **_utmb**: Google Analytics *cookie* which records the time of entering the website. It expires 30 minutes after the last update.
- **_utmz**: Google Analytics *cookie* used for interoperability with the urchin.js tracking code. It is deleted when you close your browser.
- **_utmt**: Google Analytics *cookie*. This *cookie* is used to process the type of request made by the user. It expires at the end of the session.

- **_utm**: Google Analytics cookie. This *cookie* is used to segment demographic data. It expires at the end of the session.
- **_utmz**: Google Analytics *cookie* which stores the traffic source or a campaign that explains how the user reached the website. It expires 6 months after the last update.

REVOKE CONSENT TO INSTALL COOKIES

HOW TO DELETE COOKIES FROM YOUR BROWSER

3. Click Show Advanced Options.
4. In the 'Privacy and security' section, click Content Settings.
 - Delete cookies: Click See all cookies and site data...
 - Do not allow cookies to be stored.
5. Click Remove all.
6. Close and restart the browser.

COOKIES: Requirements for VALID CONSENT to use cookies

REQUIREMENTS FOR CONSENT TO BE CONSIDERED VALID

1. **Specific information:** Consent must be specific and based on appropriate information. Generic consent is not acceptable without specifying the exact purpose.
2. **Time:** Consent must be given before processing begins.
3. **Active choice:** Consent must be unequivocal. It must be an active indication of the will of the Data Subject. It must leave no doubt as to the intention of the Data Subject.
4. **Freely granted:** Consent is only valid if the Data Subject is in a position to make a real choice and there is no risk of deception, intimidation, coercion or significant negative consequences if the Data Subject does not consent.

PROCEDURES FOR OBTAINING CONSENT

1. **When using only technical cookies:** No consent is required, the user will only be informed of cookies included in the Cookies Policy.
2. **When using non-essential (non-technical) cookies:** It is mandatory to obtain consent through clear and proactive action, as well as to enable the user to revoke their consent and to be informed of the cookies installed.

BANNER INFORMING OF THE USE OF NON-ESSENTIAL COOKIES

Non-essential cookies may be installed as long as there is a transparent message in the background, which may not disappear until expressly accepted by the user and informs the user:

- That by continuing to browse the website, they accept its use of cookies.
- Of the ownership, purpose and expiration of the cookies installed.
- A link with access to the Cookies Policy used by the website with the possibility of revoking consent.

Banner actions:
